

# EXPERIENCE CHINA „FROM INSIDE“

A STUDY TRIP OFFERED BY STUDIERENDENWERKS FREIBURG

**1<sup>ST</sup>. TO 16<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2025**

## YOUR STAY IN PEKING:

The two-week study trip to the Beijing Institute of Technology (BIT) offers a wide range of insights into Chinese universities, culture, business and politics and enables intensive encounters with Chinese students, including those from German studies. Of course, the program also includes tourist highlights such as a visit to the Forbidden City and the Great Wall.

## TRAVEL COSTS:

- € 1590,- (incl. international flight, airport transfer and own contribution to visa fees, accommodation and meals)
- Optional: travel cancellation insurance (incl. cancellation costs and travel interruption insurance) without excess for € 75,-
- No further program expenses will be incurred.

## TRAVEL DATE:

September 1<sup>st</sup>. to 16<sup>th</sup> 2025

Direct flight Frankfurt - Peking with Air China

**DEPARTURE:**

- Take-off: Mon, 1<sup>st</sup> September 2025 at 4:20 pm from Frankfurt am Main (CA 958)
- Landing: Tue, 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2025 at 7:40 am in Peking

**RETURN:**

- Take-off: Tue, 16<sup>th</sup> September 2025 at 1:30 pm from Peking (CA 931)
- Landing: Tue, 16<sup>th</sup> September 2025 at 6:00 pm in Frankfurt am Main

*Transfer between Freiburg and Frankfurt Airport by ICE. We will inform you about the exact departure time.*

## LANGUAGE:

German / Chinese / English

A German language level of at least C1 is obligatory. Chinese language skill is an advantage but not obligatory.

## ACCOMMODATION:

Accommodation is in double rooms in the student residence on the BIT campus.

## PROGRAM AND COORDINATOR:

The program is designed and accompanied by the BIT. A German-Chinese tour guide is provided by an employee of SWFR. The program will focus on Chinese culture, language and various sights. A detailed daily program will be developed in July/August.

## PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Eligible to participate are students of the universities in Freiburg, Furtwangen, Offenburg/Gegenbach, Villingen-Schwenningen, Lörrach and Kehl.
- Participants on study trips in recent years are generally excluded from repeated participation.
- A German language level of at least C1 is obligatory.

## VISA APPLICATION:

The visa will be applied in group by Studierendenwerk Freiburg. In order to accomplish the application, you will have to be ready to prepare, as well as hand in all the required documents. The visa application rules for non-EU students may vary from that of EU students. Hence, a pre-inquiry regarding visa application for non-EU students has to be succeeded before the application being accepted. You are welcome to contact us if you are interested in the study trip.

## REGISTRATION:

**By 20<sup>th</sup> May** we will first collect all registrations.

**On 21<sup>st</sup> May** those who are sure to get a place will be informed - with the request to transfer the participation fee based on the payment request by 27<sup>th</sup> May Those who do not get a place will be placed on the waiting list according to the order of registration time.

**On 28<sup>th</sup> May** those on the waiting list will be informed in turn as long as there are places available from the first round. Those who move up will be asked to transfer the participation fee by 4<sup>th</sup> June using the payment request.
