







Call for proposals: A Franco-German media and blog project for Students

"Voices against Racism and Populism"

Do you want to know more about Populism and Racism? Do you want to learn the basics of journalism and write an article or make a film on the topic? Then join our Blog project! We invite you to take part in a teaching and learning editorial team and create your own text contribution or film project in a small group. From conception to publication, you will be supported by young German-French journalists or a professional filmmaker. Previous journalistic experience is helpful but not a requirement.

Project period: October 22nd to December 15th, 2025 (hybrid: online/presence)

The project contains:

A basis online workshop "Populism and Racism": we will learn to explore and reflect on the
topics of populism and racism from a theoretical perspective. Lecturer: Claude-Hélène Mayer,
Professor of Industrial and Organizational Psychology at the University of Johannesburg, South
Africa.

Dates: 4 x 90 minutes - October 22 & 29, November 05 & 12 from 6.15 to 7.45pm

• Two presence workshops in Freiburg: We will all get to know each other personally and the editorial team will start their work. In our free time, we will discover Freiburg and its surroundings with a varied program.

Dates: Friday 07.11. to Sunday 09.11., Friday 21.11. to Sunday 23.11.

Who can participate? Eligible are students at the Universities and Colleges as well as Associations of Student Unions and CROUS: Strasbourg, Mulhouse/Colmar, Basel, Karlsruhe and Freiburg. **Working languages: German and French.** (Maximum age: 30 years).

Participation in the online workshop "Populism and Racism" and in the presence meetings in Freiburg is mandatory. The maximum permitted absenteeism (online and in person) is 25%. Participants will receive a certificate of participation in French and German upon successful completion of the project. Participation in the project is free of charge and SWFR will cover the costs of meals, travel and accommodation. A maximum of 20 participants will be admitted to the editorial team.
