

## **Call for applications: two-part online workshop "Racism and Populism" & "Media Technology - Spot on Racism and Populism":**

You would like to learn more about the phenomena of racism and populism? You are interested in producing a short film?

### **Online Workshop I "Populism and Racism"**

This online workshop focuses on exploring and reflecting the themes racism and populism and then to act according to the new findings. The following topics will be developed interactively during four online workshops: (1) Populism - "Us against the others" (2) Racism as a core element of populism and how to deal with it (3) Handling of racism on the internet (4) How to deal with populism and racism.

Dates: 4x 90 minutes- Wednesday, 11., 18., 25. November, 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2020 from 19.00h to 20.30h

### **Online Workshop II "Media Technology - Spot on Racism and Populism" - Production of a short film on the topic**

In the second online workshop "spot on racism and populism" short films will be produced with the smartphone. On the first workshop day, ideas for the short films will be developed using creative writing and visualisation techniques. In between, there will be a theoretical part with some examples. First exercises for the cinematic realisation of the ideas will be made. Within a week, the videos will be uploaded by the participants on a password-protected video platform.

On the second workshop day the created films will be discussed. The participants will receive a feedback and are able to supplement and improve their films in the course of the day, for example in terms of sound, editing, comprehensibility or aesthetics. In the afternoon, the completed short films (with a maximum length of three minutes per film) are viewed together. The workshop ends with a reflection on the creative process of dealing with the topics racism and populism.

Dates: The whole day from 10.00h to 18.00h on Sunday, the 29 November and Saturday, the 05<sup>th</sup> December.

Students of the universities, high schools, Studierendenwerke and CROUS of Strasbourg, Mulhouse, Colmar, Lyon, Karlsruhe and Freiburg are authorized to participate.

Language requirements: Good knowledge of the German and French language are desirable and of great advantage. Good knowledge of the English language can be helpful for the communication.

Due to the funding criteria of the German-French Youth Office, preference is given to participants up to the maximum age of 30 years. We ask for your understanding.

It is only possible to participate in both workshops. It is not possible to attend only one of the two workshops. Maximum 20 participants. The participants will receive a certificate of participation in the French and German language.
