

## **Emergency Accommodations Terms of Use:**

Please attentively read the following details concerning emergency accommodations.

An emergency accommodation is a service from Studierendenwerk Freiburg, which does cost money.

Only Students that have not studied and lived in Freiburg before can use the emergency accommodation.

You will receive a spot in the emergency accommodations for 8 euros per night and a one-time payment of 100 euros (20€ key deposit included). You are allowed to stay a maximum of 10 days. You'll get your key deposit back before you move out, under the condition that you did not cause any damages.

In order to use the emergency accommodations, one is required to first register.

- **Registration:**

You will need your proof of approval, or proof of enrollment. The information used for your registration will be saved, but the data saved will be protected.

- **Confirmation:**

Please note, that you must confirm your need for accommodations one day before your arrival. Only then is your spot guaranteed. After your confirmation, you will receive a details concerning the time and place of your moving in.

- **Moving-in to the emergency accommodation:**

When you move in, you must bring your admission or matriculation papers, your proof of identity and your vaccination certificate. For international students it is also possible to present a current test (antigen test max. 24 hours / PCR test max. 48 hours old) instead of a vaccination certificate when moving in. In addition, you must pay a deposit of 100 euros in cash. Only students who meet these requirements and have not lived in Freiburg before are entitled to use the emergency accommodation.

- **Information and Emails:**

We will send you reminders and information concerning your emergency accommodations. The emails we send only concern important information, your request and are not spam-emails.
